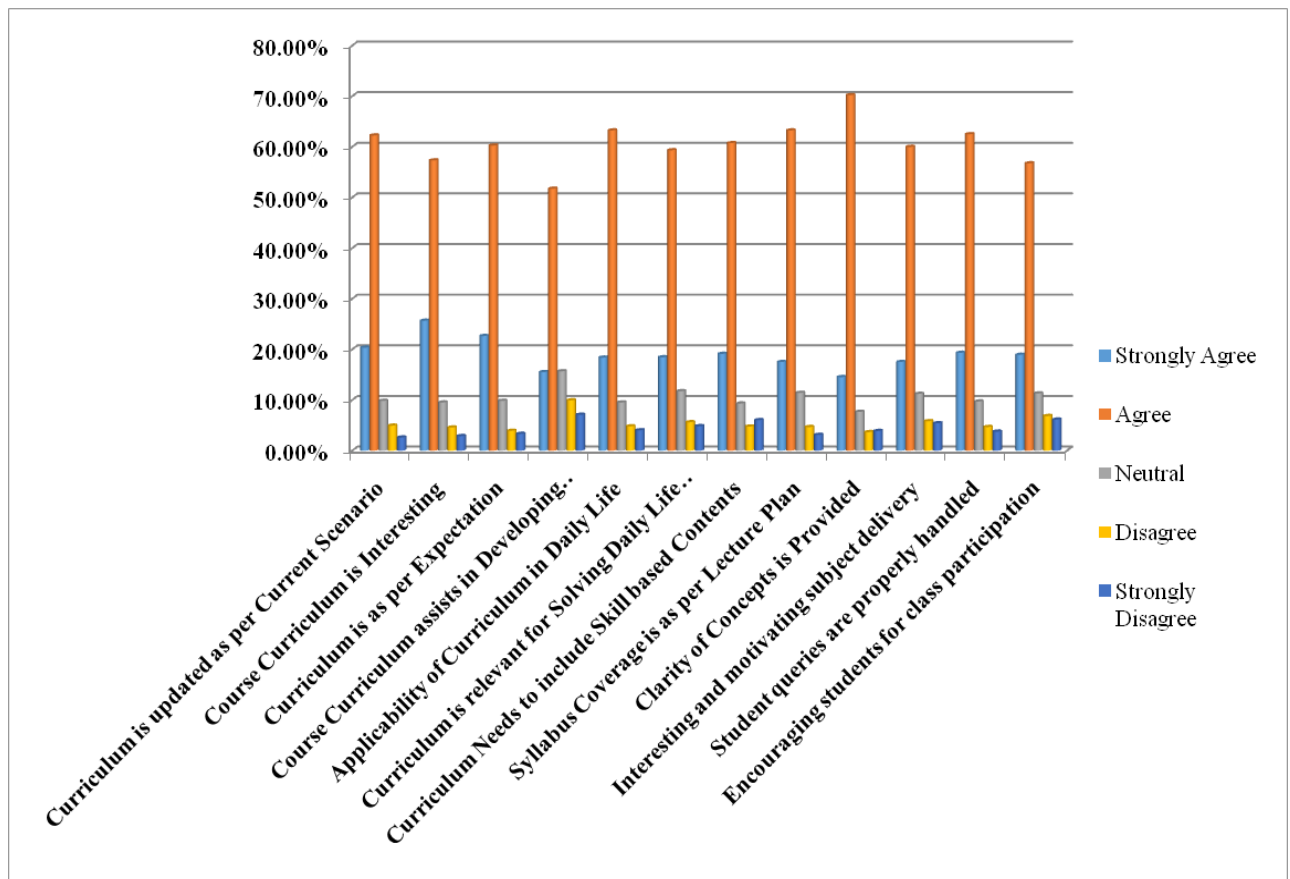

Analysis and Interpretation

1. Curriculum is Updated as per Current Scenario:

Strongly Agree (20.35%) and Agree (62.25%): A significant majority (82.60%) believe the curriculum is updated to reflect the current scenario, showing strong approval. Neutral (9.85%) and Disagree (4.95%): A smaller portion remains neutral or disagrees, indicating some room for improvement. Strongly Disagree (2.60%): Minimal strong disagreement is observed.

2. Course Curriculum is Interesting:

Strongly Agree (25.67%) and Agree (57.33%): A high percentage (83.00%) find the curriculum interesting and engaging. Neutral (9.53%) and Disagree (4.58%): Some respondents are neutral

or disagree, suggesting varied opinions on engagement. Strongly Disagree (2.89%): A small fraction strongly disagrees.

3. Curriculum is as per Expectation:

Strongly Agree (22.65%) and Agree (60.25%): A total of 82.90% feel the curriculum meets their expectations, indicating general satisfaction. Neutral (9.85%) and Disagree (3.92%): Minimal neutral and disagreement responses are recorded. Strongly Disagree (3.33%): Very few respondents strongly disagree.

4. Course Curriculum Assists in Developing Personality:

Strongly Agree (15.52%) and Agree (51.75%): A combined 67.27% believe the curriculum helps in developing personality, showing a positive perception. Neutral (15.68%) and Disagree (9.95%): A notable portion remains neutral or disagrees. Strongly Disagree (7.10%): A significant percentage strongly disagrees.

5. Applicability of Curriculum in Daily Life:

Strongly Agree (18.38%) and Agree (63.25%): A total of 81.63% find the curriculum applicable to daily life, reflecting its practical relevance. Neutral (9.52%) and Disagree (4.82%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (4.03%): A small proportion strongly disagrees.

6. Curriculum is Relevant for Solving Daily Life Problems:

Strongly Agree (18.45%) and Agree (59.33%): A combined 77.78% believe the curriculum is relevant for solving daily life problems. Neutral (11.75%) and Disagree (5.62%): Some are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (4.85%): A small fraction strongly disagrees.

7. Curriculum Needs to Include Skill-Based Contents:

Strongly Agree (19.12%) and Agree (60.75%): A total of 79.87% agree that skill-based content should be included in the curriculum. Neutral (9.32%) and Disagree (4.77%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (6.04%): A small percentage strongly disagrees.

8. Syllabus Coverage is as per Lecture Plan:

Strongly Agree (17.52%) and Agree (63.25%): A high percentage (80.77%) agree that syllabus coverage aligns with the lecture plan. Neutral (11.43%) and Disagree (4.67%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (3.13%): A minor fraction strongly disagrees.

9. Clarity of Concepts is Provided:

Strongly Agree (14.53%) and Agree (70.23%): A combined 84.76% find that the curriculum provides clear concepts. Neutral (7.67%) and Disagree (3.67%): Some are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (3.90%): A small proportion strongly disagrees.

10. Interesting and Motivating Subject Delivery:

Strongly Agree (17.52%) and Agree (60.00%): A total of 77.52% agree that subject delivery is interesting and motivating. Neutral (11.23%) and Disagree (5.83%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (5.42%): A small percentage strongly disagrees.

11. Student Queries are Properly Handled:

Strongly Agree (19.33%) and Agree (62.50%): A combined 81.83% agree that student queries are handled properly. Neutral (9.72%) and Disagree (4.68%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (3.77%): A small fraction strongly disagrees.

12. Encouraging Students for Class Participation:

Strongly Agree (18.94%) and Agree (56.75%): A total of 75.69% agree that students are encouraged to participate in class. Neutral (11.32%) and Disagree (6.85%): Some respondents are neutral or disagree. Strongly Disagree (6.14%): A small percentage strongly disagrees.

Overall Interpretation

The analysis reveals overall positive feedback on the curriculum and teaching methods. A substantial majority of respondents feel the curriculum is updated, engaging, and meets expectations, with strong approval for its applicability to daily life and clarity of concepts. There is notable support for including skill-based content and aligning syllabus coverage with lecture plans. While most respondents find the curriculum assists in personality development and handles student queries effectively, there are areas needing improvement, particularly in ensuring the curriculum supports personality development and encouraging class participation.
